Due to severe driver shortages, Pope/Douglas has had to work with the contracted local waste and recycling hauler to maintain adequate organics collection service, while still addressing collection capacity concerns at 'high-generating' organics locations.

Attached, you will find updated collection schedules for 2020 and 2021. These schedules supersede any prior verbal, written or otherwise communicated collection schedules or frequency of collection shared with your business/church/school to date. Contact Pope/Douglas to order additional organics collection carts (as shown) if your location doesn't have enough cart capacity to make it every other week. 'High-generating' locations will be serviced as shown on your attached calendar. If you feel your location should be collected every week, contact Pope/Douglas for clarification.
