



### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- Most sewer spills are preventable and are the result of misuse of the sewer system.
- Flushed baby wipes and other items cause tens of thousands of dollars in damage each year and do not break down in the sewer system.
- Flushing anything other than human waste and toilet paper down the toilet can damage household plumbing, the environment and the wastewater system.


## **NOT OK to flush:**

Baby wipes, including "flushable wipes, paper towels, cotton swabs, condoms, Tampons/pads, tissue/kleenex, dental floss, diapers, cleaning pads/wipes, medication

Remember the 3 P's only in the toilet: Pee, Poo and (toilet) paper



### **SUMP PUMPS**

#### HOW TO PROPERLY DISCHARGE A SUMP PUMP

- 1) You can have the discharge pipe empty onto your property at least 10 feet from the home. With this approach, make sure, the ground slopes away from the foundation and the pipe stays clear of debris or animals. The longer the pipe the less likely the water will infiltrate through the soil and end up back into the sump pit again.
- 2) The second option is connecting the sump pump to the storm drain, which is separate from the sanitary sewer system. This approach usually requires professional installation and may require approval from the city, but completely removes the water from your property. Contact the city if you are unsure if you have a sump pump connection at your curb.

In the City of Osakis, it is illegal to connect your sump pump or roof drains to the sanitary sewer system. (Ordinance #52.02) see more information below on Inflow and Infiltration

# GENERAL KNOWLEDGE ABOUT INFLOW AND INFILTRATION INTO SANITARY SEWER

Inflow and infiltration are defined as groundwater and stormwater that enter a sewer system. Collection systems can be damaged when they are forced to transport more flow than they are designed to handle. Increased effluent also raises costs for wastewater treatment facilities, because harmless stormwater and groundwater mix with sewage.

In many cases, inflow and infiltration (I&I) accounts for up to 45% of the annual flow to treatment plants. Removing improper connections:

- Make sure that gutters, yard drains, and sump pumps aren't connected to the sanitary sewer system.
- Repairing or replacing leaking pipes
- Cracks and leaks in sewer pipes can be caused by age, loose joints, damage, or root infiltration. Pipe replacement is expensive and disruptive, so trenchless technologies are often preferred
- Avoiding planting trees and shrubs over sewers, tree roots can damage sewer pipes and cause leaks
- Keeping cleanout caps on
- Lawn mowers can break the plastic caps on cleanouts, but replacement lids are available at hardware stores

#### **COMPOST SITE**



# Every-Other-Week Commingled Recycling

## **Guidelines**

Your recycling is single sort; you can place all items together in your container. They do not need to be sorted. Recycling cart may include the items listed below. Please set your cart out by 6:30 a.m. on collection day following these placement guidelines:

\*\* Wheels should point toward your house, away from the street. Cart should be 1 foot from curb, not the street. Cart should be 3 feet from any other obstructions such as mailboxes, trees, poles, etc. No bungee cords on the lid. IF IN DOUBT, NOTICE THE CART'S POSITION AFTER SERVICE AND PLACE IT THE SAME WAY EACH WEEK.

**ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS** – Includes small scrap pieces of clean aluminum. Labels may remain on cans.

GLASS – Please rinse. All colors of glass are accepted. Labels may remain on glass. NO BROKEN GLASS!

**PLASTIC**— Please rinse. Labels may remain on containers. Items with #1, #2 and #5 in the recycling triangles are acceptable.

### PAPER PRODUCTS/PAPERBOARD -

This includes newspaper, ad inserts, magazines, catalogs, mixed residential mail and paperboard. (Paperboard includes items such as cereal, snack and tissue boxes as well as paper grocery bags.)

CARDBOARD— Can accept small amounts of cardboard. No pizza boxes. Please break down cardboard to prevent it from getting stuck in your container.

# Please discard items not recyclable as trash.

\*\* These items are not recyclable! \*\*

Styrofoam containers, waxed or food contaminated paper, drinking glasses, windowpanes, light bulbs, broken glass, paper towels and aerosol cans.
