

Remember to Shovel Your Sidewalk!

Many people, including children, the elderly, and those using wheel chairs and strollers depend on sidewalks all year long.



To keep Osakis' sidewalks safe and pleasant for everyone, the City of Osakis' Ordinance #143 states that "no owner and the occupant of any property adjacent to a public sidewalk shall allow snow and ice to remain on the sidewalk longer than 24 hours after its deposit".

The City Council shall designate officials who shall remove from all public sidewalks all snow and ice as soon as possible beginning 24 hours after the snow has ceased to fall. The cost of such removal by the city shall be assessable pursuant to section 90.01 of Ordinance #143. If you have questions, contact Public Works at 320-859-1205 or City Hall at 320-859-2150.
