AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.11(3) OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO PERMITTED SIGNS

WHEREAS,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Osakis, Minnesota, is authorized under Minnesota Statutes and the City Code to adopt and amend zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.11 of the City Code regulates permitted signs within the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.11(3) currently limits signs placed on the exterior walls of buildings to a maximum projection of four (4) inches from the building's wall surface; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that increasing the allowable projection to twelve (12) inches provides reasonable flexibility for building-mounted signage while maintaining public safety and aesthetic standards; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the amendment promotes orderly development and is consistent with the public health, safety, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OSAKIS, MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Amendment

Section 31.11(3) of the City of Osakis Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

31.11: Permitted Signs

(3) Signs that are placed on the exterior walls of buildings shall not extend more than twelve (12) inches from a building's wall surface.

Section 2. Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more portions be declared invalid.
